### 1. Spotlight Story

Inflation Reduction Act in Action | Farm Loans: Harvesting Resilience – The Redemption Story of a North Carolina Farmer: This month, we spotlight James "Jimmy" Stevens, a devoted farmer from Whiteville who triumphed over immense challenges with support from the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Among over 20,000 producers who benefitted from the transformational assistance under the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), Jimmy's inspiring journey symbolizes resilience and the power of targeted aid. USDA's expedited aid, totaling \$1.1 billion, proved instrumental in securing the future of distressed agricultural operations, including Jimmy's. Learn and be inspired by his empowering story.

Financial Assistance Application Process Opens for USDA Farm Loan Borrowers Who Have Faced Discrimination: Earlier this month, USDA announced the opening of the financial assistance application process for eligible farmers, ranchers, and forest landowners who experienced discrimination in USDA farm lending programs prior to January 2021. Section 22007 of the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) directs USDA to provide this assistance. Since the law's passage, USDA has worked diligently to design the program in accordance with significant stakeholder input. Click on the headline to explore the initiative and how you can apply.


