#### **Acreage Reports:**

- February 14\* - wheat and other fall-planted small grains, canola, peaches
- March 15 - pecans
- May 15 - spring oats and potatoes
- July 15 - alfalfa, perennial forage, soybeans, corn and other spring-planted feed grains, CRP, all other crops

**ARC/PLC:** August 1 for annual enrollment

#### **Marketing Assistance Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments:**

- Jan. 31 - for prior year harvested wool, unshorn pelts
- Feb. 28\* - for prior year harvested peanuts
- Apr. 2 - for prior year harvested small grains and honey
- May 31 - for prior year harvested upland cotton, feed grains, soybeans/ minor oilseeds

**CRP** - Contact your county office for general and continuous CRP sign up information.

**Feb. 14\*:** Various early planted fruits and vegetables

**March 15:** Summer and fall harvested crops, warm season grasses intended for summer grazing

**May 1:** Ornamental Nursery

**Aug. 31:** Alfalfa, aquaculture, canola, Christmas trees, turfgrass sod, cool season grass intended for fall or next spring early grazing, all small grain crops for grazing or hay.

**Sept. 30:** Greens & Most perennial fruit crops

**Nov. 30:** Hay Crops(other than small grains), Asparagus, Honey, Pecans
