NAP Coverage Application Closing Dates

Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees annually by the application

closing date. Acreage reports are also due annually. Coverage for specific crops may be checked at online at www.fsa.usda.gov/nap. To ensure coverage availability, please call your local office.

Sept. 1 - Christmas Trees, Fin Fish, Flowers, Ginseng, turf grass sod, mushrooms, and plums.

Sept. 30 - all perennial grasses, alfalfa, clover, mixed forage, garlic, rhubarb, rye, triticale, vetch, wheat, and wild rice.

Nov. 20 - apples, aronia, asparagus, blueberries, caneberries, cherries, cranberries, currants, grapes, honey, hops, maple sap, pears, and strawberries.

March 15 - artichokes, barley, beans, beets, canola, corn, greens, herbs, pumpkins, sorghum, and most annual fruits and vegetables

Acreage Reports (not all-inclusive):

- September 30- Christmas trees, fin fish, flowers, ginseng, mushrooms, plums
- November 15 - Perennial grass, alfalfa, clover, mixed forage, wheat/ November 20- garlic
- January 2 - Honey
- January 15- Apples, asparagus, blueberries, caneberries, cherries, cranberries, currants, grapes, hops, pears, strawberries
- February 1- Maple sap
- July 15 - Soybeans, corn and other spring-planted feed grains, CRP, all other crops

ARC/PLC: August 1 for annual enrollment

Marketing Assistance Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments:

- March 31 - for prior year harvested wheat, barley, canola, crambe, flaxseed, honey, oats, rapeseed, and sesame
- May 31 - for prior year harvested corn, cotton, soybeans and other oilseeds, rice, grain sorghum, and pulse crops

Conservation Reserve Program (CRP): Contact your county office for general and continuous CRP sign up information.
