## PREVAILING WORLD PRICES AND LOAN DEFICIENCY PAYMENT RATES

WASHINGTON, March 24, 2021 -The Department of Agriculture's Commodity Credit Corporation today announced the following prevailing world market prices of milled and rough rice, adjusted for U.S. milling yields and location, and the resulting marketing loan gain (MLG) and loan deficiency payment (LDP) rates applicable to the 2020 crop, which will become effective today at 7:00 a.m., Eastern Time (ET). Rough prices are increased \$0.15 per cwt for long grain and \$0.16 per cwt for medium/short grain from the previous announcement.
