CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM (CRP)

Producers who have 10-year Re-enrollment CRP contracts can not begin shredding activities until OCTOBER 01, 2007, which is the start date of the 10-year contracts.

For 2007; there are no requirements for shredding unless weeds are a problem.

TRUSTS

Trust ownership is not the same as individual ownership.

Producers who have changed their land ownership to a "Trust" must bring in a copy of the filed, recorded deed to update our records.

CASH LEASES

Landowners are not eligible for Direct and Counter-cyclical Program payments because they do not have a risk in the crops.

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LOAN DEFICIENCY PAYMENTS

Producers who will harvest 2007 wheat, corn, grain sorghum, and cotton should file form CCC-633 EZ to ensure payment eligibility.

PEANUT MARKETING ASSISTANCE LOANS

REMINDER: Producers with 2006 peanut commodity loans are responsible for their peanut loans if the peanut companies do not redeem the peanut commodity loan quantity.

CONSERVATION PLAN OF OPERATION (CPO)

An updated CPO must be filed with the Natural Resources Conservation Service when farm operatorship changes.

Direct and Counter-cyclical Program payments can not be issued until this requirement is met.
