What is SCEP?

The Student Career Experience Program provides students with a paid internship and on-the-job training by working in their career field while completing their academic degree. Upon graduation, students are considered for permanent employment and may be placed in a position with opportunity for additional career advancement.

Requirements

- Students should have completed at least 60 semester hours of college.
- Students must be pursuing a degree in one of the fields mentioned above.
- Students are required to complete 640 hours of work prior to graduation.
- Students must be a U.S. citizen.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 overall grade-point average and a C average in all major studies.

Work Schedule

Students may work full-time or part-time.

Benefits

- Students earn vacation and sick days during work sessions.
- Students are paid for legal holidays within the periods of work.
- Students are eligible for life and health insurance.
