The 2007 program year began October 01, 2006. Producers may begin enrolling their farms into DCP and requesting advance payments.

Advance payments will be 22% of the total projected direct payment.

DIRECT DEPOSIT

LIVESTOCK ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM (LAGP) - 2006

The New Mexico Department of Agriculture (NMDA) is conducting a signup for producers who suffered livestock forage production losses from drought beginning March 07, 2006 to August 31, 2006.

Eligible livestock are mature foundation beef cattle and sheep (breeding stock) which are kept for breeding and reproduction.
