

The Lewis County Grain Producers are hosting a meeting on **November 6th beginning at 8:30 am at the Nezperce Legion Hall.** FSA will be there to give presentations on the new Farm Bill programs: PLC, ARC-CO and ARC-IC. We will also demonstrate the online decision-making tools that are available to producers to assist with important enrollment decisions. Learning more about ARC and PLC is extremely important since producers must make a one-time decision about base and yield updates as well as program election and enrollment.
