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## 62 Applying for the QLA Program

### A Application Submission

A producer will submit one application for the producer's entire operation nationwide in the recording County Office. The application will include all eligible crops suffering a quality loss. If a producer is applying for losses sustained in more than one crop year, a separate application is required for each crop year.

A producer may submit an application using any of the following methods:

- in person, when available
- by mail
- electronically by:
  - FAX
  - email with a scanned photocopy of FSA-898
  - other authorized method (provided by supplemental notice or other guidance).

#### **B** Complete Application

An application is considered completed when the producer has submitted all of the following:

- FSA-898, Quality Loss Adjustment (QLA) Program Application
- FSA-899, Historical Nutrient Weighted Average Worksheet, if applicable;
- FSA-895, Crop Insurance and/or NAP Coverage Agreement
- FSA-578, Report of Acreage
- acceptable records in accordance with paragraph 43.

Failure to submit the documentation for a complete application within 14 days after sign-up ends will result in FSA not being able to determine the eligibility of the producer and therefore make the producer ineligible for payment.

## **Applying for the QLA Program (Continued)**

#### C Signing and Certifying FSA-898

By signing FSA-898, the producer is:

- applying for a QLA Program payment
- certifying the information on FSA-898 is true and correct
- agreeing:
  - to comply with QLA Program regulations in CFR Part 760, subpart R
  - that the affected production of each crop on the application suffered at least a 5 percent loss due to quality
  - to provide FSA all information needed to verify the information on FSA-898 and to allow FSA access to all documents and records of the producer.

### D Additional Eligibility Forms

In addition to submitting the forms required for a complete application, the following eligibility forms must be submitted within 60 calendar days from the date the producer signed the FSA-898:

- AD-1026
- CCC-902
- CCC-941
- CCC-942 (if applicable).

**Note:** Completing eligibility forms (AD-1026, CCC-902, CCC-941, and CCC-942 if applicable) is not required before COC, or CED, review and approval of FSA-898. However, these forms must be filed within 60 calendar days of the producer signing FSA-898. Failure to timely provide all eligibility forms may result in no payment or a reduced payment. County Offices must immediately update Business File and applicable subsidiary records when the eligibility forms are filed.

### \*--E Withdrawing an FSA-898

A producer may withdraw an FSA-898 at any time after submission. A producer must request a withdrawal in writing and submit the request to the County Office where the FSA-898 was initially filed. The County Office must date stamp the written request and remove all producer signature and COC action dates from the software following procedure in 2-QLA.

**Note:** A withdrawal will be for the entire FSA-898; partial withdrawals are not authorized.--\*

#### 78 Producer Notifications

### **A Notification Requirements**

COC's must notify producers of all actions on applications, including all approvals, disapprovals, and adjustments made to any portion of the application. See Exhibit 10 for example letters, which must be modified for each determination and contain applicable appeal rights in accordance with 1-APP.

In addition to the determination letter, the notification must include:

- Estimated Calculated Payment Report
- original FSA-898 as filed
- final FSA-898, including any COC adjustments.

## \*--79 Compliance Reviews

## A QLA Application Selection

The National Office will provide a list of applications for required spot checks. The selection by the National Office is based on the following:

- random 1 percent of all approved applications by State
- targeted applications that include the following specific crops:
  - tobacco
  - pecans
  - potatoes
  - rice
  - biennial and perennial fruit crops
  - annual fruit crops
  - annual vegetable crops.

### **B** Required Employee Reviews

In addition to reviews of the applications identified in subparagraph A, compliance reviews are required for all applications of FSA employees and spouses, including STC and COC members.--\*

### C Reviewing Additional QLA Applications

State and County Office employees may specify additional applications for required spot checks. To submit additional selections, State and County Office employees must use the "QLA Compliance Reviews" link.

The link takes the employee to a form to enter the following information:

- Recording State Name and Code
- Recording County Name and Code
- Application Number
- CCID
- Parts (identify **all** parts included on the application):
  - Part C Forage
  - Part D Crops Other Than Forage with TDVL
  - Part E Crops Other Than Forage without TDVL.

Important: State and County Office employees must submit all QLA applications (FSA-898) to be added to the National Compliance Review sample by COB April 15, 2022.

#### **D** Final Producer Selection

The complete list of applications, including both random, targeted, and additional selections, may be found here: <u>QLA Review Process - Compliance Reviews - All Documents</u> (sharepoint.com).

**Note:** Additional selections will be updated by April 24, 2022.

### **E** Designating Reviewers

STC will be responsible for designating the State Office employee, including DD's, to conduct the reviews. County Office employees may not be designated.--\*

### F Performing the Reviews

All compliance reviews must be completed by a State Office employee using the FSA-898 and supporting documentation provided by the producer. All QLA compliance reviews must be completed, and results recorded according to subparagraph G by **August 26, 2022.** 

**Notes:** All FSA-898's, supporting documentation, and COC minutes documenting the determination must be submitted to the designated State Office employee using the method identified by each State Office.

The reviewer may consult with COC as needed to satisfactorily complete the questionnaire.

## **G** Handling Discrepancies

There is no level of tolerance established for QLA. All supporting documentation must correspond exactly with what was submitted on the FSA-898.

When discrepancies are discovered, the errors must be corrected immediately on the application to correspond with the documentation provided by the producer. Corrections are only permitted to be recorded in COC adjustment fields on the FSA-898. No changes will be made to producer provided information on the application.

Any additional payment must be issued, or a receivable immediately established, as applicable, and notification provided to the producer.--\*

## **G** Handling Discrepancies (Continued)

The following instructions provide guidance when a discrepancy is discovered.

**Note**: The reviewer must ensure that ECPR is printed or saved before any adjustments are made to the application.

### **H** Recording Compliance Review Results and Discrepancies

All compliance review results must be recorded in a QLA Compliance Review Workbook. A master copy of the workbook has been placed in each State folder on the QLA Review Process SharePoint site at QLA Review Process - Compliance Reviews - All Documents (sharepoint.com). The designated reviewer will:

- save a copy of the workbook to their local drive
- complete the workbook for each selection identified within the State's QLA selection list
- save the copy of the workbook with the following naming convention:
   20XX\_QLA\_Review\_Producer last name or entity name\_Producer first name. (replace XX with the applicable program year)
- protect each workbook with the password provided by the National Office QLA program specialist
- upload the protected workbook into the appropriate State folder on the QLA Review Process SharePoint site.

**Notes:** If discrepancies are discovered during the review process and any adjustments are required, the reviewer must enter all adjusted amounts as directed within the QLA Compliance Review Workbook.

#### I Review of Verifiable Records

If a compliance review includes review of a verifiable record, at the State Office's discretion, the third party shown on the record may be contacted about the accuracy of information shown on the record. If this contact is made and the third party does not affirm the record, the record no longer supports the certification and may result in other adverse action or decision for the applicant.

#### J Discovery of Fraud or Abuse

During the compliance review, if the State Office personnel suspect a violation that could constitute as fraud or abuse with the intent to defeat the purpose of QLA, follow 1-CM, Part 29.--\*

### **K** Review Questions

The following questions must be answered by the State Office employee designated to complete the review. For FSA employee reviews, additional selections, and random selections, questions should be answered for every item on the FSA-898 by physical State and county location, crop, crop type, intended use, organic status, and nutritional category, if applicable. For crop specific selections, answer all questions specific to any line items containing that crop.
