

# 2007 Kansas FSA Customer Calendar

January

## PROGRAM DEADLINES

**June 1** - Signup for 2007 Direct & Counter-Cyclical Program (DCP), without paying late fee.

### **Commodity Loans & LDPs:**

Wool & Mohair - Jan. 31  
Unshorn Pelts (LDPs) - Jan. 31  
Small Grains - March 31  
Honey - March 31  
Upland Cotton - May 31  
Feed Grains - May 31  
Soybeans/Minor Oilseeds - May 31

### **Acres Certification Deadlines:**

Small Grains for Grain - May 31  
Small Grains for Grazing - 15 days prior to grazing  
Small Grains for Haying - 15 days prior to haying  
Spring Seeded Crops - August 1  
CRP - August 1  
NAP - August 1 or 15 days prior to the onset of harvest or grazing for all other crops.

### **Graze-Out Payments:**

Wheat, oats, barley, triticale requests taken between first mechanical harvest date set for crop by COC and March 31.

### **Emergency Loans:**

Producers have eight months from the date of a disaster declaration to apply for loans to help cover production and physical losses.

### **Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP):**

**Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees by the application closing date.**

### **Application Closing Dates:**

*September 1* - aquaculture, barley, canola, Christmas trees, nursery crops, rye, speltz, triticale, turf grass sod, and wheat.

*December 1* - all grasses, alfalfa, apricots, asparagus, blueberries, caneberries, cherries, clover, grapes, lespedeza, honey, mixed forage, nectarines, oats, peaches, plums, strawberries, and vetch.

*January 1* - apples and pears.

*March 15* - coarse grains, vegetable and melon crops, amaranth, chestnuts, cotton, pecans, pumpkins, safflower, sesame, squash, and walnuts.
