

2012 NAP Application closing dates

Producers are reminded that the Non Insured Assistance Program (NAP) application closing dates for spring and summer seeded planting are fast approaching. Some of the eligible crops are vegetables, watermelons, cantaloupes, and okra. The application deadline for the crops is February 28, 2012.

Producers are required to pay \$250 service fee per crop per Parish, not to exceed \$750 per producer per Parish or \$1875 per producer in all Parishes.

Producers of commercially grown produce and fruits are encouraged to contact the local FSA Office to learn more about the NAP Program. Generally, NAP coverage will not begin until the **later** of the following dates: 30 calendar days after the completion of the application for coverage **or** the date the crop is planted not to exceed the final planting date.
