- **NAP coverage is NOT available on any crop that is insurable at the CAT Level in the County at any level of maturity. (No young orchards)**
- **Nursery Crops are Insurable in ALL California Counties.** (crop coverage can be verified by a **Crop Ins. Agent** for your county)
- **Annual crops, coverage begins the later of either of the following:**  
**30 calendar days after the date CCC-471 is filed**  
**Or the date the crop is planted, not to exceed the final planting date**
