New Committee LAA Boundary Descriptions with the combination of Bath, Menifee and Montgomery Counties.

LAA 1- Northwest Montgomery County, West side of Highway 11, West side of Highway 460 to Camargo Levee Road, to Highway 646, includes areas of Grassy Lick and Wades Mill.

LAA 2- Northeast Montgomery County, East side of Highway 11, East side of Highway 460 to Bedford Road, to Reffitt Road, includes areas of Stepstone, Howards Mill, and Hinkston.

LAA 3- Southern portion of Montgomery County includes Lucky Stop, Hope and Camargo Levee Road. West portion of Menifee County including Frenchburg, Highway 36, Highway 460 to East side of County Park Road and McCausey Ridge.

LAA 4- Eastern portion of Menifee County includes Highway 1274, Scranton, Highway 460 past County Park Road, Wellington, Mariba, Tarr Ridge, Fletcher Ridge, Denniston, and Pomeroyton.

LAA 5- Northern Bath County North of Highway 1198 to Highway 11, East of Highway 11 to Sharpsburg, North of Highway 36 to Highway 60; North of Highway 60 to I-64 to Peasticks; West side of Forge Hill Road, Riddle Road, and Ferguson Road. Includes areas of Bethel, Pebble, Oakley, Wyoming and Slate Valley.

LAA 6- Western Bath County, South of Highway 1198 to Highway 11; South of Highway 36 to Highway 965; West side of Highway 965. Includes areas of Kendall Springs and Peeled Oak.

LAA 7- Southeast Bath County. East of Highway 965 to East of Highway 36 to Owingsville; South of Highway 60 East to I-64, South of I-64 to Peasticks; South of roads – Forge Hill, Riddle and Ferguson Roads. Includes areas of Preston, Polksville, Olympia and Salt Lick.

The 2009 County Committee election will be a transition election for the combined area, with two LAA's having less than a three year term. The length of terms for the LAA's voting in 2009 are as follows: LAA 1 will be a three year term, LAA 3 will be a 2 yr. term, LAA 4 will be a one year term, LAA 5 will be a three year term


