

## MAPS for CROP REPORTING

The past few years we have provided blank maps for producers to list crops, acres, and planting dates.

Once again, we will provide these maps for you. **Please let us know when you can stop-by and pick them up.** Please call 419-289-6951.

Information on the map should include *field planting boundaries, CROP, hay types if applicable, Tillage practice, Acres, Share of the crop, and Planting date-by field (including hay)*. If field boundaries have not changed, your planted acres should balance to the field acres.

The appointment system that is being used at Ashland County FSA saves you time and helps the office prepare your files. Scheduling will be later.

AFTER PLANTING, we ask that you drop your COMPLETED maps off at least 5 (five) workdays before your appointment. There is a **night-time Drop box** on the side of the building next to the FSA/NRCS entrance.

*Dear Producer,*

*Continuous CRP signup starts October 1 and runs through September 30<sup>th</sup>. This is a great opportunity to receive Cost Share to install a Water Way and also receive a yearly rental payment. You must have cropping history 2002-2007 in order to participate in this program.*

*If you do not have cropping history in the field where the Water Way is needed there could be other program that will help you to install the Water Way.*
