## Accepting Cash

FSA County offices are no longer allowed to accept any payment in Cash (currency or coin). This is a nationwide policy. If you wish to pay in cash, please pick up a money order on the way to the office. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated!

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## Farming Operation Changes

Producers who have bought or sold land, or added or dropped rented land from their operation must report those changes to FSA as soon as possible. A copy of the deed or recorded land contract for purchased property is needed to maintain accurate records with FSA. Failure to do so may lead to possible program ineligibility and penalties.

When making record updates, be sure to update signature authorizations. Also, a review of the Direct Deposit information on file with FSA is recommended. Many of our Direct Deposit records may now be invalid or out-of-date. Any future program payments will be delayed without current and proper Direct Deposit information on file with the office. Making record changes and updating your land information NOW will save you and the County Office time when the Farm Bill programs begin arriving at the County Office.

## AskFSA

AskFSA is an online resource that helps you easily find information and answers to your Farm Service Agency (FSA) questions no matter where you are or what device you use. It is for ALL customers, including underserved farmers and ranchers who wish to be enrolled in FSA loans, farm, and conservation programs.

Through AskFSA you can:

- Access your knowledge based 24/7;
- Receive answers to your questions faster;
- Submit a question and receive a timely response from FSA experts;
- Get notifications when answers important to you and your farming operation are updated;
- Customize your account settings and view responses at any time.

## Dates to Remember:

April 1, 2014 - NAP Sales Closing Date for Spring Seeded Annual Crops. NAP service fee required.

Anytime - Reports changes in your ranching operation.

Always - Maintain good records of crop production and losses, livestock and any losses incurred.

Anytime - Schedule an appointment to help the County Office better serve you.
