Aaron W. Johnson was appointed as acting State Executive Director of USDA's Farm Service Agency in Idaho on May 1, 2013. Johnson oversees the delivery of Federal Farm Programs and Farm Loan Programs as enacted by Congress. These programs include disaster assistance, conservation, commodity and price support programs, and farm loans that are designed to improve the economic stability of the agricultural industry and help farmers adjust production to meet demand. These programs are delivered by 29 local county offices throughout Idaho.

In addition to serving as the SED, Johnson is also the Farm Loan Chief of the USDA Farm Service Agency for Idaho. Raised in Boise, Idaho, Johnson has been with the Farm Service Agency since 1991. He has served as the National President of the Farm Loan Chiefs, and a member of several national task forces.

Before joining FSA, Johnson served in management positions in three different financial institutions and worked eight years in the banking industry. He is involved in several non-profit community organizations and is actively involved in his church.

Johnson earned his bachelor's degree in Business Management with an emphasis in Finance from Brigham Young University.
