Loan and LDP Deadlines

The final date to request a CCC commodity loan or LDP on 2006 wheat, oats, or barley is <u>March 31, 2007</u>. The deadline to submit loan or LDP applications for the 2006 corn, grain sorghum, soybeans, and sunflowers is <u>May 31, 2007</u>.

For the 2007 LDP payments, participants will need to sign the form CCC633EZ, page 1, before crops are harvested.

Acreage Reporting Deadline

We are taking appointments for producers to certify 2007 wheat acreages. We will once again utilize GIS imagery to certify on the computer. Please call ahead so we can make sure we have all necessary record and map changes completed before your visit. The final date to file acreage reports for the 2007 crop of wheat, oats or barley is **Friday**, **June 1**, **2007**. Acreage reports are required to be eligible for 2007 DCP payments, NAP coverage, commodity loans and Loan Deficiency Payments (LDPs).

DCP - Direct & Counter-Cyclical Program Signup

Signup is underway for the DCP 2007 program year. The final date to sign into the DCP program is **June 1**, **2007**.

Advance direct payments of 22% can be requested any month through September 2007. The final direct payment will be made in October 2007. Advance counter-cyclical (CC) payments may also be requested.

NAP Information

March 15, 2007 is the final application date for 2007 fruits, vegetables, sorghum for forage and other spring planted forage crops.

NAP reminders -

- Producers with losses are to notify FSA within 15 days of the loss. As with crop insurance, the crop is not to be destroyed until released by a NAP crop loss adjuster.
- Producers are required to report their NAP acres timely. Producers with grazing coverage need to report the pasture acres before moving the livestock to pasture. Also, alfalfa must be reported before the first cutting is harvested.
- Producers are to provide bale counts and weights when reporting production
 of baled crops. We must have verifiable weights of the bales. The time to
 verify production is at the completion of harvest. The production needs to be
 reported so it is verifiable and has not been fed.

2006 Program Payments

In previous years, FSA has provided producer refund information on CCC-1099-G as a customer service. Since there is no IRS requirement to do so, refunds will no longer be reported on 1099's. This includes CRP participants with a payment reduction for haying/grazing activity reduced from their annual rental payment.

Refund information is available by contacting the county office or by accessing Financial Inquiries for participants with on-line access. Participants wanting to access a "Customer Statement" of their payments and refunds on-line may do so if they have a Level 2 Access account. With Level 2 Access many program benefits can also be requested on your home computer, including e-LDPs and enrolling in DCP. To set up your account, visit the USDA website located at www.usda.gov. On the bar titled My USDA, click "New User". After you complete the initial set-up, you will need to visit the local FSA office so that we can verify you as the actual user of the account.
