Featured Speakers: This year we are fortunate to have two nationally-recognized speakers and a Western US Dairy Producer at the Connecticut site.

1) Dr. Larry Fox, Ph.D., is a professor at the Washington State University. His research in Washington has focused on contagious mastitis, most recently, mycoplasma mastitis. His studies have examined the epidemiology of intramammary infection with an eye to develop intervention strategies that can be used in mastitis abatement. He has authored or coauthored more than 100 research publications, and numerous extension bulletins and lay press articles. Larry is currently NMC (National Mastitis Council) president.

2) Dr. Robert Corbett, DVM, is a consultant located in El Paso, Texas. He is a highly regarded speaker and has given over 150 presentations on dairy cattle, health, nutrition and management. He has been successful in helping dairy producers reduce contagious mastitis and, in particular, mastitis due to *Mycoplasma bovis*.

3) A dairy producer from New Mexico who has been successful in beating Mycoplasma mastitis.
