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FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

- Regions on tables 8 and 10 are defined as:

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

North Central - Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

December 2006 Sugar Market Review

Monthly Summary:

Beginning stocks in December are higher than a year ago, up 532,915 STRV. Total production is up 147,636 STRV, with beet sugar production up 50,013 STRV and cane sugar production up 97,623 STRV from a year ago. Total imports are down by 114,218 STRV. Total supply is up 566,334 STRV from last December.

Total deliveries in December are 90,473 STRV lower than a year ago. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are lower this December by 95,526 STRV. Total sales for export increased 35,945 STRV from a year ago. Total use decreased by 112,933 STRV from December 2005. Ending stocks are up 679,267 STRV from a year ago

Fiscal Year (FY) to Date Summary:

Total FY '07 production to date is up 355,730 STRV with beet sugar production up 156,007 STRV and raw cane sugar production up 199,724 STRV. Total imports are down by 229,105 STRV as well as imports for direct human consumption by 61,370 for the same period last FY. Total supply is up 492,503 STRV from FY 2006.

Cumulative sales for export to date have increased 95,520 STRV compared to the same period last FY. Total FY deliveries to date are down 168,914 STRV. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are down 172,799 STRV from last FY. Total FY use is down 187,482 STRV from the same period in FY 2006.
