FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

- Regions on table 8 are defined as:

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

North Central - Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

DECEMBER 2009 SWEETENER MARKET DATA REVISION

The December 2009 Sweetener Market Data (SMD) is revised herein because the previously reported estimates of raw and refined sugar imports, and sugar food use deliveries by non-reporters were incorrect. The procedure implemented in October 2009 for estimating these items, discussed in the September 2009 Sweetener Market Data, estimates trader (non-reporter) imported sugar sales to refiners by subtracting cane processors' raw sugar sales from cane refiners' raw sugar purchases. We assumed that reported raw sugar purchases would always be higher than raw sugar sales, the difference being the raw sugar sales by traders (non-reporters).

Unfortunately, the reporting to USDA by cane processors of raw sugar sales does not coincide perfectly with the reporting to USDA by refiners of their raw sugar purchases from cane processors. For December 2009, reported raw sugar sales by cane processors were much larger, 84,026 tons, than reported raw sugar purchases by cane refiners. Thus, for December 2009, our new method estimated a negative number for trader (non-reporter) raw sugar sales, an unreasonable result. This negative number falsely reduced raw sugar imports, increased refined sugar imports, and increased food use deliveries. The revision reported today is the result of modifying our process to prevent the use of a negative estimate of trader (non-reporter) raw sugar sales.

However, the Farm Service Agency is still not satisfied with the modified algorithm to estimate trader (non-reporter) sugar sales in the SMD and will continue to examine other modifications to the current process.

DECEMBER 2009 SUGAR MARKET REVIEW

Monthly Summary:

Beginning stocks in December are less than a year ago by 225,959 STRV. Total production is down by 71,670 STRV, with beet sugar production up 24,331 STRV and cane sugar production down 96,001 STRV from a year ago. Total imports are down by 80,257 STRV. Total supply is down by 377,887 STRV from last December.

Total deliveries in December are down slightly by 2,047 STRV than a year ago. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are down 4,775 STRV. Total sales for export are up by 4,597 STRV from a year ago. Total use is up 5,300 STRV from December 2008. Ending stocks are down 467,213 STRV from a year ago.

Fiscal Year (FY) to Date Summary:

Total FY 2010 production to date is up 6,568 STRV with beet sugar production up 125,035 STRV and raw cane sugar production down by 118,464 STRV. Total imports are down by 234,375 STRV, Refined imports are down by 70,707 for the same period last FY. Total supply is down 389,636 STRV from FY 2009.

Cumulative sales for export are up by 4,955 STRV, compared to the same period last FY. Total FY deliveries to date are up 69,720 STRV. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are up 63,216 STRV from last FY. Total FY use is up by 26,007 STRV from the same period in FY 2009.
