## **Farmers Reminded to File Crop Reports to Avoid Late Fees**

Lexington KY, July 10, 2006 – Farmers who participate in Farm Service Agency (FSA) programs are reminded to file their 2006 crop report by July 17, to avoid a late-reporting fee. Annual crop reports are required to retain FSA program eligibility.

A complete crop acreage report is required for farms participating in the Direct and Counter-cyclical Program (DCP), Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) or request a commodity loan or Loan Deficiency Payment (LDP).
