

Local Administrative Area Changes for Rockingham and Strafford Counties

As a result of land use changes, new farmers and programs available, a realignment of Local Administrative Areas' (LAA) is needed.

This year an election in each LAA will take place. The current COC members will fulfill their position through December of this year.

Nominations will be taken in all LAA's for COC members. Elected COC members will take office on January 1, 2012.

The NEW LAA's will be as follows:

LAA 1 - Milton, Middleton, New Durham, Farmington, and Rochester

LAA 2 - Somersworth, Rollinsford, Dover, Madbury, Lee, Durham, and Newmarket

LAA 3 - Strafford, Barrington, Northwood, Deerfield and Nottingham

LAA 4 - Candia, Raymond, Epping, Fremont, Chester, Auburn, Londonderry, Derry, Sandown, Danville, Kingston, Hampstead, South Hampton, Newton, Plaistow, Atkinson, Salem, and Windham.

LAA 5 - Newington, Portsmouth, New Castle, Rye, Greenland, Stratham, Newfields, Brentwood, Exeter, East Kingston, Kensington, Hampton, Falls, Seabrook, Hampton, and North Hampton


Terms will be staggered during the upcoming election.

LAA 1 & LAA 4 will be elected to serve a term of 2 years. LAA 2 & LAA 3 will serve a term of 3 years. LAA 5 will serve a term of 1 year.
