NAP Coverage Application Closing Dates

Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees annually by the application closing date. Acreage reports are also due annually. Coverage for specific crops may be checked at online at www.fsa.usda.gov/nap. To ensure coverage availability, please call your local office.

Sept. 1 - value loss crops (aquaculture, Christmas trees, sod, etc.)

Sept. 30 - perennial forage and fall seeded small grains

Dec. 1 - honey

Jan. 2 - maple sap

November 20 - fruit trees/perennial crops (apples, asparagus, blueberry, hops, etc.)

March 15 - spring seeded crops

Farm Program Deadlines - Contact your local office for more information or to make an appointment.

Acreage Reports:

- **July 15** - all other crops
- **August 15** - spring forage seeding
- **September 30** - value-loss and controlled environment crops (except nursery)
- **December 15** - perennial forage, fall-seeded small grains
- **January 2** - honey
- **January 15** - apples, blueberries
- **January 31** - maple sap

Marketing Assistance Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments:

- **March 31** - for prior year harvested wheat, barley, canola, crambe, flaxseed, honey, oats, rapeseed, and sesame
- **May 31** - for prior year harvested corn, cotton, soybeans and other oilseeds, rice, grain sorghum, and pulse crops
