## Signing up for eNewsletters/Alerts

**You can now get FSA program information and reminders via eAlerts and GovDelivery through email or text options. Enrolling is easy!**

- Visit your local FSA office & mention eAlerts. You can choose to receive information via text, email or both. You can also email your county office and request to be added to eAlerts. [Click here](#) to view a county office contact list.
- If you participate in multiple counties, indicate which counties you wish to receive eAlerts from.
- To receive text messages, we will need your cell phone number and the name of your cell phone carrier. Standard text messaging rates apply. Check with your carrier about your current text messaging plan.
- If signing up at the local office, you may be asked to complete an AD-2047 in which you will provide your email and cell phone number. This form also allows you to elect to only receive electronic correspondence from FSA. What does this mean? By electing to only receive electronic correspondence, you choose to no longer receive bulk mailings from your local office. So, if budget were to allow us to print newsletters in the future, you would be choosing to only receive your newsletter electronically and not through standard mail.
