<b>January</b>	
<b>1</b>	New Year's Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>1</b>	Elected County Committee members and alternates take office.
<b>15</b>	Final date to report apples, grapes and peaches.
<b>21</b>	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. FSA offices are closed.
<b>31</b>	Final availability date for 2012 Marketing Assistance Loans and LDPs for wool and unshorn pelts.
<b>February</b>	
<b>18</b>	George Washington's Birthday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>19</b>	2013 DCP/ACRE program sign up begins.
<b>28</b>	NAP application closing date for rice.
<b>March</b>	
<b>15</b>	NAP application closing date for many NAP crops, including forage and pasture.
<b>31</b>	Final availability date for 2012 Marketing Assistance Loans and LDPs for small grains and honey. <i>(Since the 31<sup>st</sup> falls on an a weekend, MALs and LDPs would be accepted until 4/1)</i>
<b>May</b>	
<b>1</b>	NAP application closing date for ornamental nursery.
<b>15</b>	Final date to report spring oats and potatoes.
<b>27</b>	Memorial Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>31</b>	Final availability date for 2012 Marketing Assistance Loans and LDPs for feed grains, upland cotton, soybeans and minor oilseeds.
<b>June</b>	
<b>3</b>	2013 ACRE sign-up period ends.
<b>17</b>	County Committee nomination period begins. Nomination forms are available from your local FSA Office.
<b>July</b>	
<b>4</b>	Independence Day. FSA offices are closed.
<b>15</b>	Final date to report CRP, burley tobacco, corn, cotton, grain sorghum, hybrid corn seed, popcorn, rice, soybeans and all other crops. NAP crops must be reported by the final reporting date or 15 days before harvest.
<b>August</b>	
<b>1</b>	Final date to request a reconstitution-combining or dividing farms or tracts of land based on the farming operation.
<b>1</b>	Last day to file County Committee nomination forms at the local FSA Office.
<b>2</b>	2013 DCP sign-up period ends.
<b>September</b>	
<b>1</b>	NAP application closing date for greens, aquaculture, Christmas trees, ginseng root, turf grass sod, mushrooms and floriculture. <i>(Since the 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a weekend and the 2<sup>nd</sup> is a holiday, applications will be accepted through 9/3).</i>
<b>2</b>	Labor Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>30</b>	NAP application closing date for strawberries and fall-seeded small grains.

<b>October</b>	
<b>14</b>	Columbus Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>November</b>	
<b>11</b>	Veterans Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>15</b>	Final date to report apiculture and pasture, rangeland and forage.
<b>20</b>	NAP application closing date for apples, apricots, grapes, nectarines, peaches, pears, plums, prunes and blueberries.
<b>28</b>	Thanksgiving Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>December</b>	
<b>1</b>	NAP application closing date for honey. <i>(Since the 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through 12/2)</i>
<b>3</b>	Last day to return voted County Committee ballots to the local FSA Office.
<b>15</b>	Final date to report fall barley, fall wheat and all other fall-seeded small grains. <i>(Since the 15<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend, reports will be accepted through 12/16)</i>
<b>25</b>	Christmas Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
<b>31</b>	NAP application closing date for potatoes.
<b>Ongoing</b>	
Reports of <b>Failed Acreage</b> must be filed with the County Office before disposition of the crop.	
Reports of <b>Prevented Planting Acreage</b> must be filed with the County Office no later than 15 calendar days after the final planting date for that county.
