## THE BURLINGTON SERVICE CENTER COUNTY COMMITTEE ELECTION RESULTS

**County Committees:** The Farm Service Agency county area/committees are responsible for the administration of Federal farm programs at the local level.

The County Committee counted the ballots received on December 6<sup>th</sup> 2007 for LAA2 and LAA4. The results were as follows:

Todd Ryan received the majority of votes in LAA2, electing him to a 3 year term as member of the County Committee.

Mary Simpson collected the 2<sup>nd</sup> most votes, making her the 1<sup>st</sup> alternate to the County Committee for LAA2.

Janet Cooper received the majority of votes in LAA4, electing her to a 3 year term as member of the County Committee.

Jeremy Cook received the 2<sup>nd</sup> most votes, making him the 1<sup>st</sup> alternate to the Committee for LAA4.

Todd Ryan and Janet Cooper were both previous members of the County Committee. Allen Seiter's position representing LAA5 will up for reelection this year.

A Chairperson and Vice Chairperson will be elected for 2008 from the COC Members at the January County Committee Meeting.
