Agriculture Adventures: Kentucky

Boyle Co. Conservation District hosted for the second year, a hands-on activities workshop for all Boyle County and Danville fourth graders on November 14 & 15, 2007. Approximately 600 students had several activities available to them such as grinding wheat into flour, milking a “cow”, matching products and farm crops, studying animal by-products and future land use. Free Tree Seedlings Available Late March

The Boyle County Conservation District will be giving away 4,000 tree seedlings in honor of Arbor Day. Of the 4,000 trees, approximately 1,100 will be given to third grade students in the Danville and Boyle County school systems and 2,900 will be given to Boyle County landowners.

The give-away will begin during approximately the end of March on a first come/first serve basis and will continue until all seedlings are gone. There is a limit of 10 per landowner. The seedlings being purchased from the KY Division of Forestry include: Redbud, White Pine, Yellow Poplar, Black Walnut and Pecan.
