**2006 FINAL DIRECT AND 2005 FINAL
COUNTER CYCLICAL PAYMENTS.**

Producers in Carroll, Gallatin and Trimble Counties participating in the Direct and Counter Cyclical Payment Program will be receiving a Final 2005 Counter Cyclical (CC) payment on corn in October. The Final 2006 Direct Payment will also be processed in October to participating producers.

BANK ACCOUNT CHANGES

All FSA Payments, (DCP, TTPP, CRP, NAP) are to be issued electronically into your bank account, unless there is a Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Hardship Waiver Request on file with the County Office. In order to make timely payments, you need to notify the County office if you close your account or if another financial institution purchases your bank. Payments can be delayed if we are not aware of changes to your account and routing numbers.
