Farm Record Review

The FSA office is mailing letters with computer generated farm maps to all landowners listed in our office records. Most of the letters have been mailed in Elliott and Lawrence Counties and the office is currently mailing the letters for Carter County. Boyd County was completed back in the Spring.

The purpose of this mailing is to give the landowner a copy of their farm's map as listed with the county office so that they may review farm boundaries and crop field acreages. If the crop field boundaries are incorrectly drawn, the landowner will be able to work with the office to correct them.

We are currently running behind on these corrections, so please be patient with us. As soon as the corrections are made, you will be mailed a corrected copy of your map for review.

Also, if you have not received this letter and map, they will be mailed to you by the end of December.

County Committee Election

Farmers in local administrative area (LAA) 4 and 5 in Carter County will be voting this year to elect representatives to serve a three year term on the Area Committee (COC).

Harmon Suttles, who is ineligible to seek re-election due to a nine year term limit, will be leaving the committee. We wish to take this opportunity to thank Mr. Suttles for his dedication and service to the farmers in the service area. He will be greatly missed.

Candidates on the ballot include:

Ballots will be mailed to eligible voters **no later than November 4, 2006**, by a selected contractor. County Offices will have a supply of locally created ballots (FSA-669B's) to provide to voters not on an eligible voters list or for walk-in voters.

Area committees are responsible for the delivery of Federal farm programs at the local level.

The seven member committee meets once a month with regular session meetings open to the public. The committee has established 10:00 a.m. on the second Thursday of each month as its regular meeting time and the USDA Service Center in Grayson as its meeting place.

We will post a notice on the county office bulletin board if the committee must reschedule the time or place of its next meeting.
