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COUNTY COMMITTEE ELECTION BALLOTS COUNTED AND ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING HELD

On December 5, 2007 ballots were counted for the LAA #3 County Committee election. The results of the ballot count were as follows: Curtis Lee Turner was elected as the county committee member for LAA#3. Elected as first alternate was Glenda B. Carter and Gary M. Anderson was elected second alternate. Mr. Turner will be serving his first term as a Committee person. Committee terms are for 3 year periods.

The annual organization meeting of the Cumberland County Farm Service Agency (FSA) Committee was held on January 9, 2008. At that meeting Kim McCoy was elected as Committee Chairperson. Elected as Vice-Chairperson for the 2008 year was Jo Anne Smith. Curtis Lee Turner will serve as the regular member.

The duties of the County FSA Committee member include:

- administering farm program activities conducted by the County FSA Office
- informing farmers of the purpose and provisions of the FSA programs
- keeping the State FSA Committee informed of LAA conditions
- monitoring changes in farm programs
- participating in county meetings as necessary
- performing other duties as assigned by the State FSA Committee.

REMINDER TO REPORT

If you purchase farmland, please bring a copy of your deed to the Farm Service Agency office. Although the deed is recorded in the County Court Clerk's office, this does not mean the FSA office has a record of the purchase. You may be missing out on program benefits, including payments. The same holds true if you inherit or otherwise gain ownership of farmland. Proof of ownership should be provided to the Farm Service Agency office as soon as possible.

CHANGES IN DIRECT DEPOSIT INFORMATION

Please do not forget to contact the Farm Service Agency office if you change any direct deposit information. This includes changing banks, account numbers, from checking to savings accounts, account titles, or even if your bank is bought by another bank. We certainly want all payments to be deposited correctly. Inaccurate records may cause a delay.
