## NAP & FORAGE MEETING

A tentative meeting to discuss NAP (Noninsured Assistance Program) and other forage issues has been scheduled for February 8, 2008 at the Extension Office. This is a joint meeting the FSA and Extension Service. If you have hay and/or pasture the deadline to purchase a NAP policy is March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. If you have vegetables and/or fruits, the deadline to purchase the policy is March 15, 2008. If you are a limited resource producer (with a limited income) these policies may be free to you. NAP policies guarantee 50% of the expected production on your crop. The fees are \$100 per crop per pay type with a maximum of \$300 per county. Please try to attend the scheduled meeting. Watch the newspaper for final date and time. For more information you may contact the office.
