### COUNTY COMMITTEE ELECTION

Ballots will be mailed November 3, 2006 to the Bald Knob area for the 2006 County Committee Election. Nominees are Barbara Ayers and J.W. Luttrell. December 4, 2006 is the last day to return voted ballots. We encourage all eligible voters to vote and participate in your Committee election. This area will not vote again for 3 years. If you do not receive a ballot feel free to call and we will provide you with a ballot.

### LONG TERM COMMITTEEMAN LEAVING

Marvin Polsgrove has served on the County Committee since 1990. He is not eligible for reelection this year. Marvin has been the Chairman of the Committee since 1994 and has seen the office thru some very trying times. After losing a full time CED (Office manager) Franklin was forced to share a manager with Shelby County and more recently with Scott County. With the retirement of Nancy Richardson in November of 2005 the office was forced to only be open one day per week and most work was done in Scott County. Hopefully that will be solved very soon. Franklin County Committee has become very versed in "making do with what we have" and Marvin has been very patient and understanding. He always remembered the small farmer in all his Committee work.

Marvin started his work in 1955 as a Community Committeeman. With his County Committee years Marvin has a total of 43 years of service. He has been a great asset to Franklin County and will be missed.

### OCTOBER PAYMENTS

The office will be processing payments for 06DCP (grain program). Farmers with a grain base that enrolled in the spring and completed their crop certification will receive their final 06 payment.

Producers who enrolled in 05DCP will also receive a 05 Counter Cyclical payment. Corn base holders will receive an 05 payment of \$0.35 per bushel due to the 05 market price being deficient of the target price set by Congress. Payments will be based on individual bases and yields.
