Final Dates to Apply for 2007 Crop Year Grain Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments

The final date to apply for a loan or loan deficiency payment for 2008-crop year wheat, barley, or oats is March 31, 2008. The final date to apply for a 2007-crop year corn, grain sorghum, or soybean loan or LDP is May 31, 2008.

Crop Reports


Producers are reminded to report planted acreage of small grains before May 31, 2007. Crop reporting only takes a few minutes and a balanced crop report (inventory of all cropland on the farm) is a requirement for farms participating in the Direct and Counter Cyclical Payment Program.
