Rebecca McIntosh Re-elected to County Committee

Rebecca B. McIntosh of Adairville is beginning her second three-year-term representing South Logan on the FSA County Committee. Mrs. McIntosh was re-elected without opposition in the December election.

Having been an educator for 27 years, Mrs. McIntosh worked with the Logan County Schools for 3 years and the Russellville Independent Schools for 24, with her last five years being at the Russellville Central Office, prior to her retirement She left the school system and became executive director of the Logan County Economic Development Commission (now LEAD), a position in which she served for three years.

For the last five years, Mrs. McIntosh has taken an active role in the farming operation, Scattered Acres, which she and her husband, Phillip McIntosh, operate with his uncle Kent and wife, Anne McIntosh. The McIntoshes farm approximately 5000 acres, concentrating entirely on grain, with a 100 percent no-til operation. Tobacco was also a big part of their operation for a number of years.

Mrs. McIntosh has served as chairman of the county committee for the past two years. Other members are Barry Joe Wright, Jon Taylor Barrow and Bobby Joe Miles. She emphasized that the Farm Service Agency "is a service agency for the farmers, and we want the farmers to know that the committee members are here to assist them anyway we can."

Besides her work with the FSA, Mrs. McIntosh is a member of the Russellville Rotary Club and serves on the Logan County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors. The McIntoshes are also members of the United Methodist Temple. They have four children and three grandchildren.

CED Woodward Retires

Winston Woodward, who has worked with FSA part-time and full-time for more than 16 years, retired Dec. 6. Woodward served as a field reporter for 10 years, received COT training for one year and was Logan County CED for the last five years. He was on medical leave for most of 2007 because of complications from surgery which he underwent in March 2006. Simpson County CED David Burch has been serving as acting CED in Logan County until a new director is named.
