The County Committee election for the term beginning January 1, 2007, will be held in Local Area Administrative Area (LAA) 2 in Mason Co. and in LAA 4 in Robertson Co. Ballots will be mailed to eligible voters by November 3, 2006.

The completed ballots are to be postmarked or returned to the Mason – Robertson County FSA Office not later than **December 4, 2006**.

The nominees and the boundaries of each LAA are as follows:
