COUNTY COMBINATIONS COMPLETED

In an effort to streamline FSA and make adjustments for shrinking workload and retirements, as of October 19th, 2007, the Johnson-Floyd-Martin-Pike FSA Office and the Wolfe County FSA Office were closed and combined with the Morgan-Magoffin FSA Office in West Liberty, Ky. The Office is now known as the USDA Service Center in West Liberty, Ky.

The County Committee has been combined for meeting purposes for 2008 and includes 3 members from Morgan County; 2 members from Magoffin County; 3 Members from Wolfe County; 2 members from Johnson County and 1 member from Floyd County. The COC will be reviewing Local Administrative Boundaries (LAA's) in the spring to redraw these boundaries to reduce the number of LAA's from 11 to 5 (the maximum number allowed under the current regulations). The COC currently meets on the third Monday of each month at 9:00 am. All meetings are open to the public and we extend an open invitation to all producers.

The County Committees are to be commended for their spirit of cooperation in making the adjustments necessary to bring these offices together. It has been a difficult time for the Counties who have lost their office, but the COC's have acted in a helpful and selfless manner to ensure services to their producers. In like manner the County Office Staff has worked hard to make this transition as smooth and effective as possible. The office is coming together with the anticipation of a New Year and new farm bill. It is our goal to provide timely and accurate assistance to all producers in every county. If we fail to meet this goal please let us know. We are here to help you, please help us in this endeavor.
