BOUGHT OR SOLD LAND

Please remember if you sell or buy land let us know. Any one that buys land needs to bring in their deed, survey and social security numbers of buyers listed on the deed. There is a form that the seller and buyer need to sign in the Nelson Co FSA Office before any change in ownership can be done in the office. If someone sells their whole farm, then the only person responsible for coming in is the buyer with the information listed above.

DIRECT DEPOSIT

Please remember to visit the Nelson County FSA Office if you have changed banks or account information. If this office has the incorrect account or banking information your payment will be held up, and no payment will be distributed until we have the correct information on file. There are two options you have on getting this information corrected. Bring a check with you to the office and we will make a copy, or there is a form you can take to your bank and they can fill out the correct information.
