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LIVESTOCK COMPENSATION PROGRAM

The Appropriations Act of 2007 has been passed to include the 2007 drought. This means that all producers will be paid for ONLY one year (either 2005 or 2007). All payments will continue to be paid based on the number of animals contained in the herd. If your herd size did not increase from 2005 – 2007, you will not need to re-apply. If you had an increase in animals in 2007, you will need to make an additional application to receive the difference from your 2005 – 2007 herd count.

LIVESTOCK INDEMNITY PROGRAM

The Appropriations Act of 2007 also includes livestock deaths due to qualifying moisture and drought conditions through 2007. This means that all producers will be paid for ONLY one year (either 2005 or 2007). All payments will continue to be paid based on the number of animals that died in either 2005 or 2007. If your number of deaths in 2007 were more than 2005, you will need to make an additional application to receive the difference in number of dead livestock.

LAND SALES AND PURCHASES

If you have bought or sold property in Pendleton County, please bring in a copy of your deed along with the social security numbers and addresses for all owners listed on the deed. Timely filing these ownership changes will prevent a delay in processing farm program benefits.
