DISASTER PROGRAMS:

LIVESTOCK COMPENSATION PROGRAM:

We are currently taking applications for the 2005 and 2007 disaster years. You are eligible for a disaster payment if you owned cattle on February 1, 2005, or 2007, that weighed a minimum of 500 pounds. Please call or come by for more details and to see if you qualify.

CROP DISASTER PROGRAM:

We are currently taking applications for 2005, 2006, 2007, disaster years. If you purchased Federal Crop Insurance or NAP during any of these years and received an indemnity or had a 35% loss, you may qualify for a disaster payment.

FARM LOANS AND YOUTH LOANS:

If you're interested in loans to operate your farm or look to diversify and try new crops, our Farm Loan personnel are located in Shelby County and will be glad to talk and meet with you in our Versailles office if you're interested.
