Wool/Mohair Program

Beginning with the 2006 crop year, Wool and Mohair producers will find applying for USDA loan deficiency a little EZer this year thanks to the Farm Service Agency's new CCC-633 EZ form

Instead of completing the form before you shear, you can now **sign up before you sell**.

Two (2) step process

Step 1: Sign CCC-633EZ, Page 1 before losing beneficial interest.

This is the LDP agreement, stating that the producer has intentions to request LDP's for all eligible commodities.

Step 2: Sign CCC-633EZ, Page 4 – Requesting Payment(s)

This is a request for payment. Page 4 must be signed each time the producer requests an LDP.

What is the Wool/Mohair LDP Program?

The Wool/Mohair LDP program helps stabilize the wool and mohair industry (producers receive **additional monies** due if prices are low at the market).

How much do I get paid? Your payment depends on the date when your wool/mohair is sold.

Where can I sign-up? You can sign-up at any USDA Service Centers. A Bi-Lingual (Navajo/English) FSA representative is available at scheduled Navajo Chapters Houses Visits. **Check local chapter for schedules.**

Non-Insured Crop

FSA is now taking applications for **2007** Non-insured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (**NAP**) on Native Grass (**Rangeland**).

The NAP program provides financial assistance to producers for Native Grass (Rangeland) should there be a 50% or more loss during the crop year due to a natural disaster (drought).

To **sign-up**, please complete a **CCC-471** (NAP Application), **CCC-441** (Income Certification) at your local FSA office or at scheduled sign-ups.

The **NAP "Service Fee"** is **\$100.00** per crop per county.

Service Fee is waived if your total household income is \$22,549 or less.

Sign-up Deadline: October 31, 2006
