FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

TABLE NOTES

- Regions on table 8 are defined as:

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

North Central - Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.


South - Delaware, Maryland, District of Columbia, Virginia, West Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.

West - Alaska, Hawaii, Montana, Idaho, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico, Arizona, Utah, Nevada, Washington, Oregon, and California.

Puerto Rico - entered separately and included with U.S. total.

Starting with the November 2009 SMD report, Table 1-A, which separates statistics for the raw and refined sugar markets to improve analysis of the domestic sugar market will be included until further notice. This is a departure from Table 1 which blends statistics from both the raw and refined sugar markets in the traditional USDA format. The difference between the raw and refined price in the past decade has demonstrated some independence in the related markets and the need to differentiate statistics.

November 2009 Sugar Market Review

Monthly Summary:

Beginning stocks in November are less than a year ago by 72,792 STRV. Total production is down by 81,939 STRV, with beet sugar production down 31,975 STRV and cane sugar production down 49,964 STRV from a year ago. Total imports are down by 63,399 STRV. Total supply is down by 218,131 STRV from last November.

Total deliveries in November are up by 50,136 STRV than a year ago. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are up 45,781 STRV. Total sales for export have decreased by 1,444 STRV from a year ago. Total use is up 38,661 STRV from November 2008. Ending stocks are down 256,793 STRV from a year ago.

Fiscal Year (FY) to Date Summary:

Total FY 2010 production to date is down 209,001 STRV with beet sugar production up 117,042 STRV and raw cane sugar production down by 22,463 STRV. Total imports are down by 152,958 STRV, imports for direct human consumption are down by 71,230 for the same period last FY. Total supply is down 267,379 STRV from FY 2009.

Cumulative sales for export are up slightly by 359 STRV, compared to the same period last FY. Total FY deliveries to date are up 40,472 STRV. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are up 36,695 STRV from last FY. Total FY use is down only by 10,588 STRV from the same period in FY 2009.
