### NEBRASKA FSA ANNOUNCES ADDITIONAL PUBLIC MEETINGS

Lincoln, NE, April 19, 2007 – Nebraska Farm Service Agency announced plans today to hold two additional public meetings in an effort to gather information and to listen to producer comments regarding proposed FSA office consolidations. The agency recently completed twelve public meetings in potentially impacted communities.

Public meetings will be held in Dakota County and Hitchcock County during the first week of May.

May 4, 2007, 10:30 a.m. CDT – Trenton Community Development Commission Building, 402 E. 1<sup>st</sup> St., Trenton, NE

“The State FSA Committee wants to be very thorough in this process and feels two additional public meetings will help us to make the most informed decision possible when it comes to submitting the final proposal,” said Brian Wolford, State Executive Director.

The format will be the same as prior meetings including a presentation by FSA followed by the opportunity for the public to offer comments and to ask questions about the FSA Office Structure proposal, according to Wolford.

“No decisions have been made on any of the proposed locations. Today begins a new 30-day comment period for Dakota and Hitchcock Counties,” said Milt Rogers, State FSA Committee Chairman. The comment time for the original twelve locations ends on April 27, 2007.
