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FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

OCTOBER 2006 SUGAR MARKET REVIEW

Monthly Summary:

Beginning stocks in October are higher than a year ago, up 365,159 STRV. Total production is up 165,024 STRV, with beet sugar production up 86,937 STRV and cane sugar production up 78,087 STRV from a year ago. Total imports are slightly up by 10,711 STRV. Total supply is up 540,894 STRV from last October.

Total deliveries in October are 57,259 STRV lower than a year ago. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are lower this October by 62,758 STRV. Total sales for export increased 28,017 STRV from a year ago. Total use is higher by 21,185 STRV from October 2005. Ending stocks are up 519,708 STRV from a year ago
