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FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

- Regions on table 8 are defined as:

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

North Central - Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

South - Delaware, Maryland, District of Columbia, Virginia, West Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.

October 2009 Sugar Market Review

Monthly Summary:

Beginning stocks in October are lower than a year ago by 209,001 STRV. Total production is up 176,518 STRV, with beet sugar production up 149,017 STRV and cane sugar production up 27,501 STRV from a year ago. Total imports are down by 93,160 STRV. Total supply is down 125,644 STRV from last October.

Total deliveries in October are down 13,266 STRV than a year ago. Deliveries for domestic human consumption are down by 12,688 STRV. Total sales for export are up by 1,803 STRV from a year ago. Total use is down 52,851 STRV from October 2008. Ending stocks are down 72,792 STRV from a year ago.
