- 2) Contact information;
- 3) Degree (major and type);
- 4) Work/volunteer experience;
- 5) Supervisor's name, phone number and email address for each work period listed and whether or not we may contact them for reference;
- 6) If a current student, include the expected graduation date.

CURRENT TRANSCRIPT

An unofficial copy is sufficient with the application; however if selected, an official college transcript will be required.

VETERANS

Bring a copy of individual Discharge Papers (DD214) and any other relevant VA documentation.
