1 Procedure for Sending Pork Referendum Materials to AMS

A

Background

The Department of Justice has requested all voting materials used in the pork referendum. The materials are to be sent to AMS in Washington, D.C.

Notice AO-1236 required County Offices to retain all referendum materials in the custody of the CED until December 10, 2001.

B

Purpose

This notice instructs County Offices to send all pork referendum material by Federal Express to AMS in Washington D.C.
