7 (Ctd)	Control Table	<p>Note: If moving producers because of an office consolidation, new LAA's may need to be created through "ADD an Entry" in the closing office and in the gaining office before performing a mass update.</p> <p>Example: County B is closed and combined with County A. The combined county jurisdiction will have 1 COC with 5 LAA's that represent both counties. County A's LAA's remain as LAA 1, 2, and 3 in the new combined COC jurisdiction.
