1 Overview

A Background

All COC's and Service Centers are required to ensure the fair representation of SDA (minority and female) producers in the area over which COC has jurisdiction. FSA uses the most recent NASS Census of Agriculture data to identify counties with a 10 percent or more population of minority principal farm and ranch operators. The counties identified using NASS Census of Agriculture data are required to take extra efforts to obtain minority nominees for COC election. Using the definition of SDA producers, both minority and female producers are included in all efforts to increase diversity on COC's. SDA producers and their organizations must be encouraged by all counties to file FSA-669A for themselves, in the case of an individual, or for a candidate of their choice.

B Purpose

This notice:

- reissues the list of counties with a 10 percent or more population of minority principal operators
- requires COC's from jurisdictions with any listed county to make extra efforts to obtain an SDA candidate for the 2010 COC election.

Counties identified in Exhibit 1 were determined by using the NASS 2007 Census of Agriculture data based on minority (not SDA) principal operator statistics for each county in the nation.

2 Service Center Actions

2 Service Center Actions (Continued)

B LAA Requirement

In multi-county Service Centers, LAA or LAA's in a listed county is/are required to have a minority nominee. This requirement may be waived if there is:

- adequate documentation that the Service Center performed extensive COC election outreach with respect to minority producers
- a minority voting COC member currently serving whose term will carryover into 2011.

Every effort must be made to obtain an SDA candidate if a minority candidate is not nominated after all efforts by COC and Service Centers are exhausted. This can also apply in single-county Service Centers (alternates and minority advisors do **not** qualify).

3 State Office Action and Contacts

A State Office Action

State Offices shall:

- ensure that each Service Center with a county listed in Exhibit 1 obtains a minority or female candidate **before the end of the nomination period**
- require any Service Center with a county listed in Exhibit 1 that does not obtain a minority or female candidate, to provide a narrative of why a minority or female candidate was not nominated.

Note: State Offices shall provide the contacts listed in this notice with copies of any narratives received from a county explaining why a minority or female candidate was not nominated.
