**1 Inflation Adjustment of Acquisition-Related Thresholds**

**A Background**

The Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2005, Section 807 (Pub. L. 108-375) provides for acquisition-related threshold adjustments every 5 years except for the Davis-Bacon Act, Service Contract Act, and trade agreement thresholds. One of the thresholds recently changed in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) is the micro-purchase threshold (FAR 2.101).

**B Purpose**

This notice:

- identifies the new micro-purchase threshold
- increases the purchasing authority of Government purchase card holders whose purchase limit is \$2,500
- applies to all National and Field FFAS Offices supported by FSA procurement.

**C Action**

The micro-purchase threshold was increased from \$2,500 to \$3,000. FFAS Local Agency Program Coordinators are authorized to increase the purchase card limit to \$3,000 for all Government purchase card holders whose purchases are restricted to the micro-purchase level.
