**1 Publicizing Method of Division**

**A**

**Background**

The designation by landowner method is the division of contract acres, allotments, and quotas in the manner agreed to by the parent farm owner and purchaser or transferee.

This method of division may be used to divide tracts or farms.

Cases have been submitted to the National Office for review because land owners and purchasers were not aware:

- that they had the option to use the designation by landowner method to divide the contract acres, allotments, or quotas
- of FSA-155 signature requirements or the use of a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

This notice provides instructions to County Offices for publicizing the designation by landowner method of division.
